Ice-cream, 2 scoops. Your choice of flavour


Topping of your choice

Spray cream

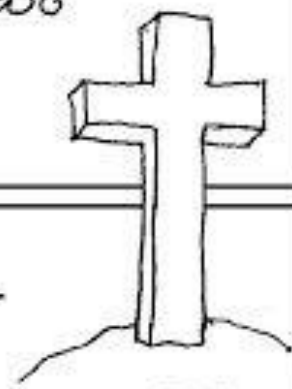
1. Cut your banana in half long ways and then place it in a bowl.

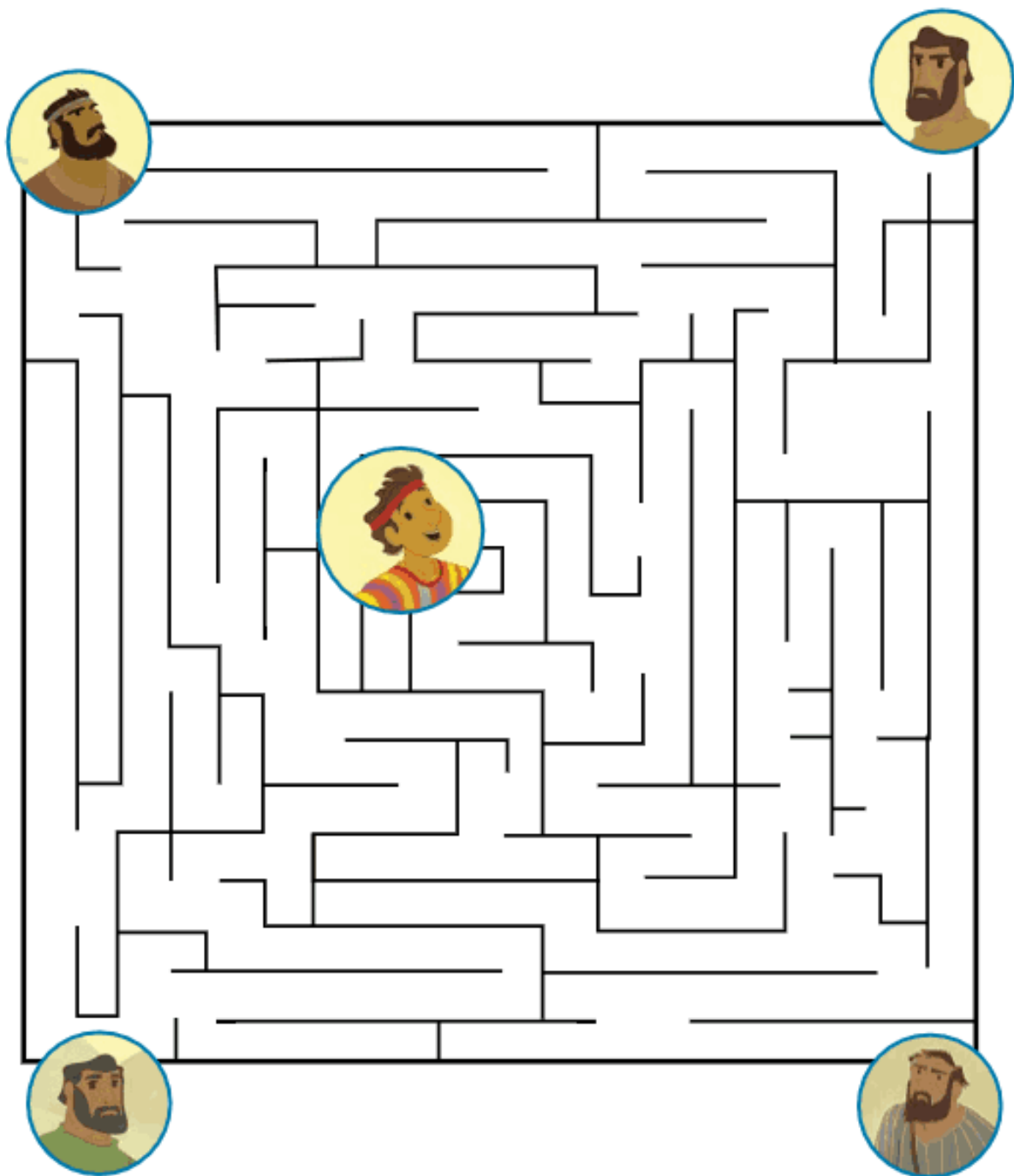
